What are the benefits to children?

The design of our programmes is determined through an in-depth assessment procedure, in conjunction with national guidance and assessment schemes, including Asset Languages and Anglia Exams.

Will my child's tutor be a qualified teacher?

Our tutors are either experienced teachers or have demonstrated a keen interest in entering the teaching profession. You may of course express your preference for a qualified teacher during the registration procedure

How will my child be taught a foreign language?

Whether children are preparing a picnic or playing tennis with their tutor, they will be learning a foreign language at their own pace. Our tutors are trained to maximise learning opportunities, by responding to children's interests. They make use of a range of strategies to ensure that language is as meaningful as possible, using gesture and action to reinforce children's comprehension of the spoken word.

Can my tutor live in?

Yes. This arrangement makes home tutoring a more affordable option, as tutors are willing to accept board and lodgings as part remuneration for their work.

However, we do ask families to restrict contact time with children to a maximum of 25 hours per week, as this allows tutors time to prepare activities and ensures that they are able to maintain the energy, which children demand!
